## GRADING POLICY UPDATE (2024–2025 ACADEMIC YEAR)

Beginning with the 2024–2025 academic year, IMG Academy implemented semester summative assessments, administered in both the fall and spring semesters. These assessments account for 20% of a student's final course grade each semester and are designed to evaluate cumulative understanding and mastery of course content.
