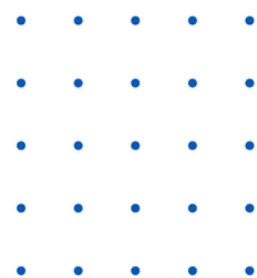

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TRAVEL INFORMATION

DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

When you travel to IMG Academy, you must carry the following documents with you:

- Passport
- Visa
- Form I-20
- SEVIS receipt
- Letter of acceptance from the school
- The address of where you will be staying
- The telephone number of IMG Academy in case problems at the airport

DO NOT PACK THESE IN YOUR CHECKED BAGGAGE

Keep these documents at hand to show to the Customs Officials and when you come to the IMG Academy Orientation.

PORT OF ENTRY: ARRIVING IN THE US

New (initial) students with an F-1 student visa may be admitted to the U.S. up to 30 days before their course of study begins.

All visitors entering the USA must state their reason for entering the country. If you are attending IMG Academy, and are in possession of a valid SEVIS form, tell the CBP Officer that you are a student.

Once your inspection to successfully completed, the inspecting officer may:

- Stamp your passport. For F-1 visa holders, [the stamp must say D/S](#).
- Students who do not have [“D/S” written on their I-94 or on a stamp in their passport](#) must check their I-94 arrival record online: <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/i94/#/home>. If you arrived in student status, your record will say F-1 D/S. In case it states anything else, please contact your International Student Advisor immediately. Students should report to their school within 30 days of the date that appears on the SEVIS I-20 form to register for courses or to validate their intended participation. Failure to do so may result in serious consequences.

IMG ACADEMY CHECK-IN

We will need a number of documents to facilitate the international student check-in process. Please bring the following items to the Admissions & Enrollment Office:

- Your passport with visa
- Original I-20 form (this document has three pages)

WHAT TO EXPECT ON CHECK-IN DAY

Check-In Day at IMG Academy is an exciting start to your journey with us! We strive to make this process as smooth and efficient as possible. Here's what you can expect.

Please note this is a sample check-in schedule intended to give you an idea of what to expect. Some activities, timing, and details may change.

DURATION

The check-in process typically takes about 2 hours. However, this timeframe can vary depending on how many pre-arrival tasks have been completed ahead of time.

ADDITIONAL TIME FOR BOARDING STUDENTS

If you are moving into the dorms, please plan for additional time beyond the initial check-in process to settle into your new home.

SAMPLE CHECK-IN ITINERARY:

MORNING:

2 HOURS: ARRIVE TO CAMPUS, PACKET & ID PICK-UP & COMPLETE CHECKLIST

- Collect your welcome packet, checklist and Student ID.
- Complete checklist as required.

1 HOUR: MOVE-IN

- Boarding students move into dorms with the help of our welcome team.
- Day students tour the campus and meet their day advisors.

1 HOUR: LUNCH BREAK

- Enjoy a meal in the Campus Center and mingle with fellow students and faculty.

AFTERNOON:

2 HOUR: FREETIME AND UNPACKING

- Settle in, unpack, and get comfortable in your new space.

1 HOUR: DAY STUDENTS & FAMILIES MEET & GREET

- Day Students and families can meet with the Student Life Day Student Manager.

1 HOUR: DINNER BREAK

- Enjoy a meal from one of our on-campus dining options in the Campus Center or at the ICON Eatery & Bar located at the Legacy Hotel.

EVENING:

1 HOUR: SPORT ORIENTATIONS

- All students are required to attend their respective sports' orientation meeting to be introduced to the sport staff.

END THE DAY: DORM FLOOR MEETINGS (ALL DORMS)

- All boarding students required to attend their floor meetings before curfew to meet their Primary Residential Mentor.

We are thrilled to welcome you to our Ascender Family and look forward to supporting you throughout your time at IMG Academy. Please make sure all forms are completed and submitted prior to your arrival to ensure a smooth check-in process.

2026-27 TUITION PAYMENTS FAQs

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR PAYING THE TUITION AFTER COMPLETING ENROLLMENT?

In order to finalize enrollment, a deposit of \$10,500 (Domestic Students) or \$13,000 (International Students) would need to be submitted and processed

- This deposit will go towards the total tuition due.

After enrollment is confirmed, families will receive an invoice via email from our accounting team outlining the balance on the tuition payment.

- New student invoices typically start being sent mid-April. Returning student invoices typically start being sent out late-May. If enrollment is finalized after June 1, invoices will be sent within 3 weeks of enrollment.
- Please refer to your invoice for wire transfer details. Note: Mailing checks close to Check-in Day is not recommended due to potential delays.

First payment after enrolling will be due on June 1st. IMG Academy offers two payment options:

- Pay in Full Option
 - Remaining balance can be paid via wire transfer or check
- 10 Month Payment Plan Option
 - Monthly payments may be done via wire transfer, check, or credit card via the online payment portal.

HOW IS THE 10-MONTH PAYMENT PLAN BROKEN UP?

An initial payment of is due on June 1st with the remainder of the payments being due on the 1st of each month for the next 9 months (July - March).

- A credit card may be placed on file for payment plans.

Regardless of the enrollment date, the tuition account must be up to date by Check-In Day, per the payment structure outlined on the Tuition Enrollment Agreement for a student-athlete to begin sport and school activities.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I ENROLL AFTER JUNE 1ST, BUT WANT TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE PAYMENT PLAN?

If a family enrolls after June 1st and choose the Payment Plan option, the family will be responsible for catching up on the prior due dates.

For example, a family who enrolls on July 15th will be responsible for paying the June 1st and July 1st payments.

CAN I CHANGE MY PAYMENT PLAN OPTION?

Families can change between the 'Pay in Full' options and 'Payment Plan' option up until Check-In Day. After Check-In, the selected payment option is final.

IF I PAY OFF MY PAYMENT PLAN EARLIER THAN 10 MONTHS DOES MY TOTAL AMOUNT OWED CHANGE?

The total amount owed is determined based on the selected payment plan option. If the Payment Plan option is selected, amount owed is the amount listed on the Tuition Enrollment Agreement regardless of payoff date.

HOW DO I SET UP AUTO PAY FOR MY MONTHLY PAYMENTS?

WHAT IF I FALL BEHIND ON MY MONTHLY PAYMENT AFTER CHECK-IN?

If a family knows they will be going to be late on a payment, please communicate with us as soon as possible so we can work together on a plan to keep the account current.

- If payment has not been received by the 20th of the month, a student-athlete may be withheld from Sport Activities.
- If payment has not been received by the 25th of the month, a student-athlete may be withheld from Academics.

WHAT ARE THE WIRE TRANSFER INSTRUCTIONS?

Please send wire transfers via regular wire.

- Funds sent via ACH transactions may not be immediately identified and may be delayed in posting to the Student Account.
- Please reference the student-athlete's name and Opportunity number in the notes.
- Processing fees may be incurred during the transfer and they are the responsibility of the family.
- The amount of the credit to the tuition account will be the exact dollar amount received by IMG Academy.

HEALTH & REGISTRATION FORMS - SCHOOLDOC

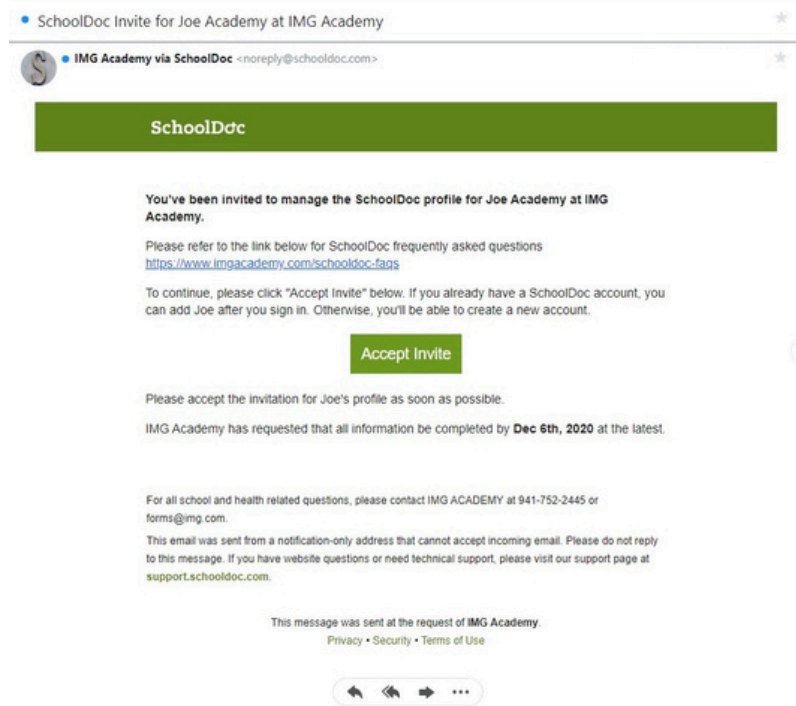
IMG Academy requires all Participants to complete registration & health forms before participating in our Boarding School program, including a [FHSAA ECG Screening Form](#) (EL1), a [FHSAA Physical Evaluation Form](#) (EL2), an Immunization Record, and valid health insurance coverage.

If the conditions below pertain to your Participant, please note that there may be additional documentation that may need to be signed by a doctor.

- Bringing medication to campus
- Has allergies that cause anaphylaxis
- Injuries or concussions within the last six months
- History of Asthma, Diabetes, or Seizure Diagnosis
- Personal or family history related to cardiac conditions or diagnosis
- If your participant has any medical treating specialists

To complete the required forms, you will need to log in to your SchoolDoc account. All required registration & health forms must be completed prior to campus arrival. Once all forms have been submitted, our Customer Support Team will review them to ensure they are completed accurately and will reach out directly if any items are missing or require attention.

Below is an example of what an email invitation from SchoolDoc will look like.



CAN'T ACCESS YOUR ACCOUNT?

HOW DO I COMPLETE MY FORMS?

Forms need to be submitted via SchoolDoc. You should have received instructions on setting up your account in your confirmation email. If you have not received those details, please contact the Customer Support Team at IMGA.SchoolSupport@imgacademy.com.

WHAT IF I CAN'T COMPLETE ALL THESE FORMS BEFORE CHECK-IN?

We are happy to help you as much as we can in order to get them complete, but failure to complete these forms can delay your student's ability to participate in sport activities.

WHAT IF THE INVITATION LINK IS INVALID OR EXPIRED?

SETTING UP YOUR ACCOUNT

1. You will be prompted to create an account with the email address you were invited with. (Figure 1)

2. Once you've accepted the invite, you will be prompted to add your personal information as a parent/legal guardian (name, phone, address).

- As a parent/legal guardian, you should fill in this section with your own contact information. You will be able to add your Participant's details at a later time.
- Click **"Confirm"** once all information is complete in this step, and then **"Save"** to move forward.





WHAT DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED?

COMPLIANT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

IMG Academy requires the Participant to be compliant with the State of Florida requirements, not the state or country of original residency. All participants must have documented immunizations as required by the State of Florida prior to arrival on campus.

If the Participant is exempt from Immunizations, we will require a DH681 form to be completed.

If the Participant is a Day Student, we will require a DH680 form to be completed.

If the Participant is a Boarding Student, we will require an official immunization record from their state or country of origin in English.

FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

[FHSAA EKG/ECG Screening Form \(EL1\)](#)

If the Participant has a medical exception to the ECG/EKG Requirement, we will require a [Medical Exception Form \(ME01\)](#) and Section A of the [FHSAA ECG Screening Form \(EL1\)](#) to be completed by a United States-based physician in English.

All other Participants are required to upload a completed [FHSAA ECG Screening Form \(EL1\)](#) with an EKG Screening Test done on or after July 1st, 2024 by a United States-based physician in English.

[FHSAA Physical Evaluation Form \(EL2\)](#)

All Participants are required to upload a completed [FHSAA Physical Evaluation Form \(EL2\)](#) on or after May 1st, 2026.

The mandatory [EL2 Form](#) should be downloaded, partially completed by the Participant's Parent/Guardian, and finalized by a United States-based physician in English.

VALID HEALTH INSURANCE

Valid Florida Insurance is mandatory for all Participants. If you do not have a United States-based private insurance plan that meets IMG requirements, you must either purchase your own insurance plan and provide the information OR purchase a plan through Omni International Insurance Services [HERE](#). SCHOOL DOC FAQs

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE AN EMAIL FROM SCHOOLDOC?

You will receive a welcome email from SchoolDoc within 24 hours of enrollment. The email will be sent to the person who signed the Tuition Enrollment Agreement (TEA). If you would like to add a secondary email address to your Participant's health profile, you can add new authorized users to the profile through the 'Manage Users' tab, and an invite will be sent to the additional user.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I HAVEN'T RECEIVED THE EMAIL FROM SCHOOLDOC OR FORGOT MY LOGIN?

If you forgot your login information or cannot locate the original email, visit app.schooldoc.com and select "Forgot Password." Be sure to use the same email you used to register. Devices such as iPads, Android tablets, and Chromebooks do not meet the school's technology requirements and are not compatible with several of our instructional platforms and digital assessments. As such, they should not be used as a student's primary device.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Each dorm is supported by a dedicated Student Activities Coordinator who works closely with Residential Mentors to plan and deliver a wide range of engaging on- and off-campus activities including community service opportunities. These activities take place during students' free time, outside of academic classes and athletic training.

The core activity schedule operates on a bi-weekly rotation (A Week and B Week), providing a consistent yet varied program for students. In addition, coordinators organize pop-up events, themed weeks, special trips, and larger community-wide events throughout the year, ensuring there are always opportunities for students to get involved and build connections. The full activity schedule is available on Teamworks and is also displayed in the lobby of each dorm for easy access.

REACH: STUDENT LEAVE REQUEST SYSTEM



IMG Academy has implemented the REACH Student Life Management system to enhance the safety and security of student-athletes.

Key features of this platform include:

- **PAPERLESS LEAVE REQUESTS**

REACH allows boarding student-athletes to submit leave requests electronically, streamlining approvals for parents/guardians, hosts, and school staff.

- **PARENT/GUARDIAN APPROVAL VIA EMAIL**

Leave approvals are granted through automated emails sent to parents/guardians- [no separate REACH account is needed.](#)

- **MANDATORY LEAVE APPROVAL**

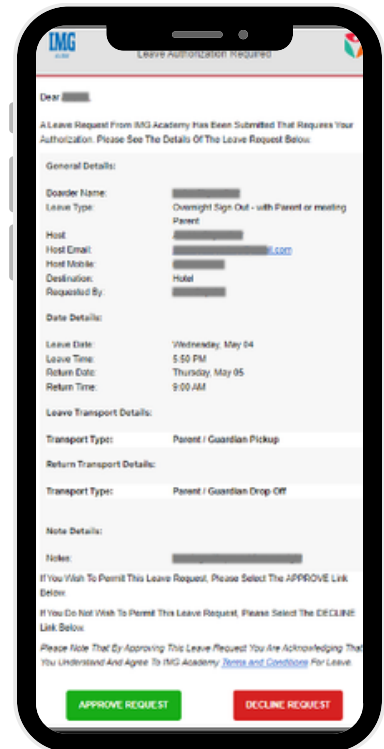
All leave requests must be approved in REACH before a student-athlete can leave campus, unless it's an IMG-chaperoned trip.

- **REAL-TIME UPDATES**

Once a leave request is approved, REACH records the action and notifies Student Life that permission has been granted.

- **SECURE ACCESS & GUIDANCE**

Student-athletes receive login credentials and training for REACH; additional steps may apply depending on the leave type and host involved.



THE PROCESS

1. The student-athlete will create a request to leave campus through the REACH system.
2. Parents/guardians will grant this permission through the automated email that REACH will send upon the student-athlete's submission of the leave request. Based on Academy procedures, parents/guardians may be asked to verify and give permission for a particular leave.
3. If approved by the parent/guardian, the action is recorded by the REACH system and will inform Student Life that permission has been granted.

Additional approval steps may be required from the designated Host and/or IMG Academy staff contingent upon the Leave Type. For more information, please refer to the Student-Athlete and Parent Handbook.

VEHICLE AND PARKING INFO

VEHICLE POLICY:

WHAT ARE THE POLICIES, WHAT ARE ALLOWABLE?

- Boarding Students: Students who are at least 18 years of age are permitted to have a vehicle on campus. They must register the vehicle with the Academy and provide a copy of the students' valid license, proof of insurance, and registration.
- Day Students: Students who are at least 16 years of age are permitted to drive their vehicle to and from campus. They must register the vehicle with the Academy and provide a copy of the students' valid license, proof of insurance, and registration.
- Registration sticker must be displayed on the students' vehicle.

ON-CAMPUS TRANSPORTATION

- Non-motorized bikes are allowed on campus. All bikes must be registered via a Campus Safety Officer.
- Golf carts, e-bikes, e-scooters, e-skateboards, and other like motorized modes of transportation are strictly prohibited for all student-athletes, including Day students, and guests at IMG Academy. Only IMG Academy staff are permitted to operate a golf cart.

PARKING:

Parents dropping off their students should park in the lot near the Welcome Center located in the Campus Center. Please ask the entry gate upon entering if you have questions regarding parking or directions.

IMG Academy offers a Tram Service to navigate campus upon arrival and during your student's stay. There is a tram stop located behind the Campus Center. If you are staying at Legacy Hotel, we also offer parking on-site as well as a Valet Cart service that operates upon request to campus.

CAMPUS SAFETY & INCLEMENT WEATHER

WHAT MEASURES ARE IN PLACE TO KEEP MY STUDENT SAFE?

ARMED SECURITY PRESENCE

- IMG Academy maintains a 24/7 security presence consisting of trained and certified armed and unarmed personnel. Our team is focused on prevention, rapid response, and maintaining a safe environment for all student-athletes, staff, and visitors. Regular emergency preparedness drills are conducted to ensure that both staff and students are familiar with established safety protocols and can respond effectively in a variety of situations.

ACCESS CONTROL AND SURVEILLANCE

- IMG Academy utilizes a comprehensive, layered approach to campus security. Access to campus is monitored and controlled through designated entry points. We also utilize a comprehensive access control system to monitor, regulate, and track individuals entering and exiting various locations on the property.
- Surveillance cameras are strategically placed throughout the campus to enhance visibility and monitor key areas, contributing to a proactive security approach.

WHAT MUST WE DO SO OUR STUDENT MAY HAVE A BICYCLE ON CAMPUS?

- Pedal bicycles are permitted on campus provided they are registered each academic year with Campus Safety.
- All bicycles must be secured using appropriate locks and stored only in designated bike rack areas located throughout campus.
- For the safety of our community, motorized bicycles, electric bikes, scooters, and similar modes of transportation are prohibited on campus.
- Additional details can be found in the IMG Academy Student Handbook.

WEATHER SAFETY

In case of rain or inclement weather, all of our sport programs have a rain contingency plan for every session. Our coaches can pivot at a moment's notice in order to continue instruction safely.

Weather Safety Alerts will go into effect if lightning or other inclement weather is within a certain distance from the Academy. An alarm will sound to notify all staff and student-athletes that campus is under a weather safety alert. When weather conditions are at their most severe, all persons will be required to remain indoors until the weather safety alert is lifted. A second alarm will sound to notify all persons on campus that the weather safety alert has been lifted.

If student-athletes need to get anywhere while a weather safety alert is in effect, our transportation department will arrange for buses, vans or other forms of transportation to safely transport student-athletes if necessary. If it is not deemed necessary, student-athletes will stay put until the weather safety alert is lifted.

WEATHER EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

At IMG Academy, the safety and well-being of our student-athletes are our top priorities. Per the Inclement Weather Policy in the Student & Parent Handbook, in preparation for potential emergencies, such as hurricanes, we require each family to establish a clear and actionable evacuation plan. This proactive measure ensures that, in the event of a major emergency, we can swiftly and effectively minimize uncertainty during critical times. To support planning, all boarding student families must complete and submit a mandatory Evacuation Plan via an assigned IMG Academy platform.

HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED BY JOHNS HOPKINS ALL CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL



Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital provides the health care services for the students of IMG Academy. The Health Services team is honored to oversee your child's day to day health care. Health Services is an on campus facility open 24 hours per day. Care provided includes first aid, distribution of medication and supplements that are not permissible in the student's room, nurse visits or more complex physician appointments if needed during student's stay at IMG Academy. Health Services staff of nurses are available 24 hours a day to address your participant's medical needs. ADMINISTERING PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION WHILE AT IMG ACADEMY

Parents/guardians and students are required to provide Health Services with a current list of all medications, prescribed or over the counter, which the student currently takes. These must be listed on the Medication Authorization form and signed by the prescriber. It is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify Health Services in order to update the student's medication administration plan with respect to any medication(s), dosing revisions, health status changes, and submit the correct Medication Authorization form. Students who do not take medication as prescribed by their doctor or who fail to follow their doctor's orders may be considered unfit to participate in their sport program.

Parents of non-boarding students are expected to attend to students' medication needs outside of school whenever possible; however, if a non-boarding student must take a daily prescription medication during school hours, parents are expected to provide the medication in original prescription bottles with the instructions in English to Health Services for administration.

For health and safety reasons, it is our policy that Health Services administer prescription medication to boarding students. Daily prescription medication must be turned into Health Services upon check-in to school. All medications must be in the original prescription bottles with the instructions in English for administration with the student's name, date of birth and all prescribing information. Health Services will work with local pharmacies to fill prescriptions if this is necessary for your child while attending boarding school.

Medications will be dispensed by Health Services staff or by Academy personnel who have been designated in accordance with the Academy's policy regarding the administration of prescription medication. Students are required to report to Health Services to receive their prescription medication in accordance with their treatment plan and missing a required dosage may result in disciplinary action and/or removal from participation in their sport program.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY STUDENT-ATHLETE DOESN'T COME TO TAKE HIS MEDICATIONS?

Notices are sent to you and your child that a medication dose has been missed. If the dose continues to be missed these messages are escalated and a parent/guardian phone call is initiated.

DO ALL MEDICATIONS FOR MY STUDENT-ATHLETE NEED TO BE KEPT IN HEALTH SERVICES EVEN THOUGH MY STUDENT-ATHLETE HAS MANAGED THEM ON THEIR OWN AT HOME?

Yes. There are only a few medications that student-athletes may keep in their rooms - among them emergency medications. A full list is available for you from Health Services.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN MY STUDENT-ATHLETE IS SICK?

Your student-athlete is seen by a nurse in Health Services and assessed as to problem and plan for care. If your student-athlete is feverish or infectious they will remain in Health Services until that time has passed and they can be released. If a higher level of care is required, a physician appointment will be made in consultation with the parent/guardian.

Emergency allergy control medication (EpiPens), topical creams, cleansers, eye drops, inhalers, nasal sprays, oral contraceptives, insulin, ibuprofen, non-sedating and non-decongestant antihistamines including Zyrtec (Cetirizine), Claritin (Loratadine), and Allegra (fexofenadine); throat lozenges/cough drops and other over the counter medications approved in writing by Health Services.

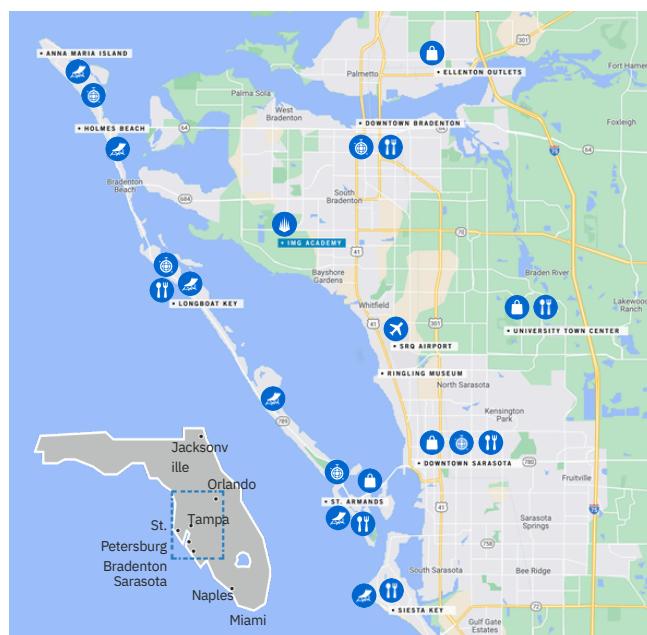
